Canterbury Boys High School offers an Enrichment Program for boys who exhibit high potential across a range of learning domains.

The ALPHA Program continues the school's enrichment focus into Stage 6. It extends senior students' depth and breadth of thinking by developing an excellent work ethic and by challenging them with new ideas and practices.

The program focuses on students developing skills, behaviours and attitudes that will lead to HSC success and maximise their academic potential.

The ALPHA Program:

- provides students with a mentor to guide them with the development of an Individual Learning Plan based on their academic career goals
- focuses on growth goal setting and growth mindset
- develops student selfunderstanding and metacognition
- provides opportunities to interact with experts and advisors
- promotes active engagement of parents and carers in students' learning processes.



Participation in the ALPHA program requires the nomination of Year 10 students by teachers and a selection process against academic and attendance criteria. This is overseen by the year adviser and deputy principal.

Students and parents are invited to participate in an interview with the deputy principal and principal where final approval will be given.
