Canterbury Boys High School offers an Enrichment Program for boys who exhibit high potential across a range of learning domains.

The Program maximises students' academic potential, by challenging the boys to think critically, fostering a sense of curiosity and a determination to question. In the Years 7 and 8 Enrichment Program, the boys investigate concepts through cross-curricular depth studies, examining issues through creative, technological, mathematical and applied science perspectives.

Boys apply their knowledge to design, develop and create, giving them opportunities for their ingenuity to flourish. These opportunities include historical dramatic productions, interior design and developing hydroponic systems.





The Enrichment Program in Years 9 and 10 explores topics such as philosophy, comparative studies, 21st Century Media, writing for the HSC and higher order mathematics and science.
