



# Canterbury Boys High School Enrolment Policy

The placement panel (Principal, Deputy Principal, relevant Year Adviser and relevant CLO) reviews applications for enrolment.

Enrolment into CBHS will depend on the availability of appropriate staff, permanent classroom accommodation and the school's ability to meet the curriculum requirements and learning needs of each applicant.

## 1. Local Area Enrolments

Students are generally accepted if the above requirements are met. However, if the student has a history of violence, drug abuse or anti-social behaviour (disobedience or misbehaviour) that is clearly supported by suspension or expulsion documentation, advice will be sought from SED, before application can proceed. Risk assessments will be conducted using information and advice received from current school. In some cases, additional support (counselling, ISTB, RRRS, LST, ESL) may be required to ensure the student settles successfully into school.

## 2. Non-Local Enrolments / Out of Area Enrolments

To be considered for enrolment at CBHS the following criteria will be applied:

- Educational needs of student (level of support available)
- Proximity and access to the school
- Access to single-sex education
- Availability of subjects or combination of subjects
- Structure and organisation of school
- Special interests and abilities
- Medical reasons
- Compassionate grounds
- Individual students' written request outlining their learning needs
- Siblings already enrolled at school (unless enrolling student has a history of violence or has been expelled. We would expect him to apply to his local school first.)
- Safety and supervision of students before and after school
- Sister at Canterbury Girls High School.
